SARGENT: THE WATERCOLOURS 21/06/2017 - 08/10/2017 DULWICH PICTURE GALLERY

"Sargent: The Watercolours" is the first show in 100 years devoted to watercolours by the renewed Anglo-American portraitist, John Singer Sargent.

With 80 paintings from private and public collections, the exhibition reveals the artist's personal view of the world with fragmented and disorienting subjects.

Sargent took inspiration from the places he visited, from the glacial moraines in The Alps to the renaissance and baroque architecture of Venice, all demonstrating technical brilliance and striking individuality.

CHRIS OFILI: WEAVING MAGIC UNTIL 28/10/2017 NATIONAL GALLERY

Turner Prize winner, Chris Ofili, has collaborated with the internationally renowned Dovecot Tapestry Studio to translate his watercolour into a handwoven tapestry. It took five weavers three years to create the tapestry. For this show, Chris Ofili has taken over the Sunley Room at the National Gallery, dimming the lights and positioning the bright tapestry on a grey mural of Asiatic dancers. More than 24ft wide and almost 8ft high, with radiant colours of aquamarine, turquoise, rich, dark purple and green, the artwork is a reminiscence of a Paul Gauquin's painting.

SOUL OF A NATION 12/07/2017 – 22/10/2017 TATE MODERN

"Soul of a Nation" begins in 1963, the same year as Martin Luther King's famed speech 'I Have a Dream', it is a unique exhibition showcasing the creative innovation and tremendous contribution of black artists during the Civil Rights movement.

Featuring around 150 artworks, from vibrant paintings, powerful murals, collage and photography, the show focuses on how art was used as a platform for protest and a space for freedom of expression. With more than 50 influential American artists, this landmark exhibition is a rare opportunity to see artworks that illustrate a key period in US history.

FRIEZE SCULPTURE 2017

05/07/2017 - 08/10/2017

From 5th July to 8th October, Regent's Park welcomes Frieze Sculpture, London's largest outdoor exhibition by leading contemporary artists from around the world

This year, the sculpture park features 23 significant works by 20th and 21st century's artists. including three busts of black men by Thomas J Price, a six-metre-high cartoonish figure by Kaws, a white-enamelled bronze tree by Ugo Rondinone and a red steel sculpture of the outline of a wheelbarrow by Michael Craig-Martin.



BBC PROMS 2017

14/07/2017 - 09/09/2017



Each year, the BBC Proms host two months of concerts over the summer. Starting on 14th July, the event is an opportunity for music enthusiasts to enjoy the finest classical music in various venues across London but mainly at the Royal Albert Hall. Other events. such as Proms in the Park, are also held across the UK.

The programme includes more than 90 concerts and 30 premieres with leading musicians, singers, orchestras and soloists from around the world and culminates with the famous Last Night performance.

FOCUS ON SOFITEL VIENNA STEPHANSDOM
