The Gagosian Gallery, in partnership with Pablo Picasso's grandson Bernard Ruiz-Picasso, presents "Picasso: Minotaurs and Matadors", in an innovative installation designed by the Prize-wining architecture Caruso St. John.

With loans coming from museums and private collections, the exhibition begins with works from 1889, when Picasso was eight years old, and ends with the matadors and toreros he painted in 1970.

Featuring drawings, sculptures, prints, ceramics and short movies, the exhibition focuses on the artist's passion for bullfighting and mythical beasts.


INTO THE UNKNOWN: A JOURNEY THROUGH SCIENCE FICTION

"Into the Unknown: A Journey Through Science Fiction" is a festival-style exhibition of art, design, film and literature that consists of more than 800 works, most of them never seen in the UK before.

Created by historian and writer Patrick Gyger, the exhibition takes you through history, uncovering the science fiction world and explaining the changes from the 19th century to the present.

Vintage artwork illustrating Soviet visions of space, original models and objects from Godzilla and Stargate, as well as original manuscripts by Jules Vernes and iconic spacesuits from Star Trek and Interstellar are part of the exhibition.

HORSE-RACING: ROYAL ASCOT 2017
