The exhibition explores Diana's personality with 26 garments on display, including the iconic evening gown worn at the White House when the Princess danced with John Travolta

Thomas Gainsborough is one of Britain's most famous painters and the greatest 18th century portrait artist who actually started as a landscape painter.

In this exceptional exhibition, the National Portrait Gallery presents over fifty paintings from public and private collections across the world and explores his career, from a provincial artist to a celebrated painter.

Gainsborough regularly painted himself and his own family and you will discover the fascinating portraits of his daughters from childhood to adult life including "The Artists Daughters chasing a Butterfly" and the double full-length of "Mary and Margaret Gainsborough as sumptuously dressed young women".

COURTAULD IMPRESSIONISTS: FROM MANET TO CÉZANNE UNTIL 20/01/2019 NATIONAL GALLERY

In collaboration with the Courtauld Gallery which is being refurbished, the National Gallery is showcasing an exceptional number of works from the Courtauld's private collection.

The exhibition pays tribute to Samuel Courtauld, a textile industry magnate, who, back in the 1920s, set up a fund to buy paintings by Impressionist and Post-Impressionist artists.

Showcasing 40 masterpieces from Daumier to Bonnard, it includes Cézanne's Card Players and Man with a Pipe, Toulouse-Lautrec's Jane Avril in the Entrance to the Moulin Rouge, Renoir's La Loge, Manet's A Bar at the Folies-Bergère. The exhibition includes a selection of works from the National Gallery's own collection such as Cézanne's Self Portrait and Pissarro's Boulevard Montmartre at Night.


